Scriptures of Unconditional Love

They are called Scriptures of Unconditional Love because GOD is Unconditional Love (1 John 4:16) and these Scriptures will help us to walk in the ways of Unconditional Love. We should live by Unconditional Love because Moses commanded it (Leviticus 19:18) and so did Jesus the Christ (Matthew 22:37-39). There are an initial thirty of these books to be published. Some are still in process but should be ready by the end of 2026. Once they are completed, more will be added.

The Twenty-One Witness books have been updated from their previous titles and translations using the South-London English that I grew up with. I also replaced the word "church" with "community of GOD's people" and "Lord" with "RULER" as these are more accurate translations. These twenty-one were chosen because they do not contradict the Old or New Testaments in any way but rather provide us with a means to interpret the Holy Bible more accurately and with additional knowledge and understanding.

Nobody had ever told me what was going to happen when I submitted my life to Christ on a South-London Street in February 1974, aged 13. I had a physical Holy Spirit experience as an "atomic bomb of joy" exploded in my being. As I walked along the street, it was like I was floating three feet off the ground. That evening, a Spirit person visited me and wrote these words in my heart with light and fire, "Do not rebuke the church". The end result of this encounter are these Scriptures of Unconditional Love.

These are the books of Written Miracles. Ancient prophecies and predictions scattered throughout the Holy Bible's Old Testament concerning the appearance of Christ. These prophecies were made hundreds, some over a thousand, years before Christ appeared. They were all miraculously fulfilled with pin-point accuracy by Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth. There are so many of them that they could only have been put there by Holy Spirit. Certain Jewish scholars, who did not want Jesus to be their Messiah or Christ, started deleting the more obvious prophecies. You can find some of them restored in the books of the twenty-one witnesses. It is best to read the Gospels of Isaiah and King David first as they will strengthen your faith so that your heart can be prepared to receive the teachings and testimonies of the twenty-one witnesses.

The Twenty-One Witnesses

It is like we have twenty-one new witnesses presenting themselves before a court with new evidence and testimonies that GOD is real, and Christ is knowable. Some of these witnesses might have come forward from the era of 'Belonging to the Way' which was from AD 33 (Jesus's physical and spiritual resurrection from the dead) to AD 47 after which time those 'Belonging to the Way' were first called Christians. Most of the other witnesses belong to the pre-church era of the Original First Christians. This era spanned from AD 47 to AD 155 when Polycarp, the Disciple of John the Apostle, was executed for being a Christian by the Roman Empire. The Roman Church filled the vacuum with their own authority and 'brand' and were a powerful influence in starting the new 'church age'. Eventually, the twenty-one witnesses were banned from the New Testament in the fourth century by Emperor Constantine's Roman Church of Christendom, even though these scriptures were originally treasured by Christians of the first and second centuries. Fearing persecution, holders of the books managed to hide them and keep them safe. One thousand two hundred and fifty years later they began to be rediscovered again. Silence broken. Christianity unrestricted. Let them speak. Let us listen.

If they had been allowed to speak and were given their rightful place in the New Testament, they would have acted as salt and light to have a purifying effect on the religious authorities down the centuries. The world would not have experienced the abuses of zealous misguided religious powers. There would have been no crusades, no inquisitions, no witch hunts, no public burnings and no religious persecutions. There would have been no need for European colonialism either as the colonised nations would already be worshipping Christ, having destroyed their gods. The world would have been a better place as the unconditional love of Christ became the new currency that replaced cruelty. The Good Confession would have united the community of GOD's people and all the gods would have been annihilated. There would also have been no need for GOD to send the Qur'an. Having said that, the church has done a vital job in helping to get rid of many gods by either destroying or absorbing them. My hope is that these twentyone witnesses will serve to destroy the remaining gods in the world leaving Devil Satan, who has won the right to remain here, as the sole survivor from the original sin rebellion. Hindus and similar, must abandon all their gods and worship Krishna alone. You can read the books of enlightenment when they have been published, to understand more about this. It is also now time for those churches that have absorbed pagan gods and practices, to get rid of them.

The church's shortcomings can be traced all the way back to AD 154 when Anicetus, Bishop of Rome, refused to accept the Nisan 14 Passover date that Polycarp, disciple of apostle John, and the other apostles observed, regardless of the day of the week it landed on. Anicetus instead kept to what we now know as the Easter dates which should be abandoned in favour of Nisan 14.

The twenty-one witnesses reveal to mankind that all the books of the Holy Bible should be read in the context of GOD versus the gods. In this war, each one of us finds ourselves at one of five stages.

Stage One: Individuals abandon their god(s). It is better to practice

secular atheism than to worship demons.

Stage Two: Acknowledge GOD but don't agree with GOD. Presenting oneself regularly before GOD, either in a church or some other similar gathering will help your case with your Creator.

Stage Three: Agree with GOD but don't obey.

Stage Four: Try your best to obey GOD.

Stage Five: Full submission to GOD. This is perfection.

Introduction

This Written Miracle is an ancient prophecy and prediction concerning the appearing of *The Christ*. This prophecy was made hundreds of years before Christ appeared. It was miraculously fulfilled with pin-point accuracy by Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth. These prophecies and predictions belong alongside a large number of prophecies from the Holy Bible's Old Testament. There are so many of them (you can see a few of them in the Gospel of Isaiah and the Prophecy Table further on) that they could only have been put there by Holy Spirit. Certain Jewish scholars, who did not want Jesus to be their Messiah or Christ, started deleting a few of the more obvious prophecies, but it appears there were too many, so they gave up or were stopped. As these are Holy Spirit Words, when you read, hear, touch or speak them you are engaging with GOD because you are reading, hearing, touching and speaking EHYEH (EHYEH is the Name that GOD revealed to Moses in Exodus 3:14). GOD and EHYEH's Word, Holy Spirit, GOD's Name and Unconditional Love are all one and the same. As these prophecy words are miraculous, it is logical and reasonable to keep applying these miracle words for healing of the heart, spirit, mind, and body - in fact, to anything organic whether animal or plant. Why not try it and see?

Whilst this miracle Gospel is short in length, it is full of GOD's power and potency. These supernatural Words are worth

more than pure gold. Everything of value according to this world will rot and disappear, but the Words in *The Gospel of Isaiah* will never pass away but will remain with us forever (Luke 21:33).

The Gospel of Isaiah belongs to a collection of thirty books called Scriptures of Unconditional Love. There are the books of written miracles being the Four-Gospels-In-Advance, the twenty-two books of EHYEH's Witnesses and four books of Enlightenment. All these books are or will be FREE to download from www.thesoulsong.co.nz or can be purchased online as an e-book or in hard copy which you can receive by post mail.

I have added various components such as *The Prayer of Jesus* (The LORD's Prayer), *Introduction to: The Gospel of Isaiah*, *The Good Confession* and *The SoUL Song*, in case you wanted to use *The Gospel of Isaiah* as the central core of a worship activity. Worship EHYEH either on your own (Matthew 6:6) or with other people. Start with reciting "*Draw near to GOD and EHYEH will come close to you*" (James 4:8.), then go from there. Don't be too rigid or legalistic but be flexible and open to GOD inspiration as you might be touched to include or exclude Holy Spirit stuff as EHYEH moves in your heart. You might be alone or isolated, but if you humbly recite these words you will draw close to GOD who will respond by coming close to you. Keep in touch with EHYEH and GOD will never leave you or forsake you (Hebrews 13:5). You will never be alone ever again.

The Prayer of Jesus

Come near and draw close to GOD and GOD will draw near to you (James 4:8)

The Spirit of Jesus is EHYEH ASHER EHYEH which is the Name GOD told Moses when asked (Exodus 3:14).

Jesus told us to use these words when talking to GOD:

Give us enough bread to eat today.


Forgive us our sin as we have forgiven those who have sinned against us.

EHYEH ASHER EHYEH

GOD gave to Moses GOD's Name. In Exodus 3:14, GOD says GOD's Name is EHYEH ASHER EHYEH. In the 4th century, it was translated from Hebrew into Latin by the renowned Jewish scholar Jerome as EGO SUM QUI SUM. In English, it translates as I AM WHO AM.

Latin: Dixit Deus ad Mosen EGO SUM QUI SUM ait sic dices filiis Israhel qui est misit me ad vos.

English: GOD said to Moses: I AM WHO AM. He said: Therefore, you will say to the children of Israel: HE WHO IS, has sent me to you.

The Name EHYEH ASHER EHYEH may confuse a number of people who thought the Name was Jehovah or Yahweh or something else instead. In fact, in Exodus 3:15 GOD tells Moses to say that GOD's Name is YHVH (YUD-HEH-VAV-HEH). Unfortunately, ancient scholars stopped passing on the correct pronunciation long ago, so people have had to guess the spelling and so they came up with Jehovah and Yahweh etc. EHYEH = I AM. YHVH = HE IS. One is first person the other third person.

Moses was GOD's friend who talked face to face with GOD. Moses was the humblest person on earth (Numbers 12:3). GOD even shared with Moses what GOD was like as a person: "I am the RULER GOD. I am merciful and

compassionate. I show great love, and I can be trusted" (Exodus 34:6).

The people of Israel at that time were hard-hearted. After seeing many miracles whilst being set free from slavery in Egypt, they made a golden calf and start worshipping it instead of GOD.

My position is that EHYEH ASHER EHYEH is GOD's Name for those who want to be in a relationship with GOD like Moses had. YHVH-Jehovah-Yahweh is for those who recognise and appreciate GOD but prefer to keep a little distance. Either way, both Names can be called upon and GOD can be engaged with.

IHU KARAITI

Ihu Karaiti is Māori for Yahshua Messiah (Hebrew) or Jesus Christ (English). I believe, as many scholars do, that it was the Spirit of Ihu or Jesus who spoke to Moses from the burning bush. Ihu Karaiti represents the indigenous peoples' Name for Yahshua Messiah. I would like it also to represent the pre-colonial, pre-crusade and pre-church eras to reach out to everyone in the whole world.

I AM

I emphasise *I AM* because it's a Name Jesus called himself just as GOD did 1,500 years prior. Some scholars, including myself, are convinced that EHYEH ASHER EHYEH is, in fact,

the Spirit of Jesus, or the Spirit of Christ, or the Son of GOD, talking to Moses from the burning bush in Exodus 3. Jesus says I AM many times in the Gospels especially in the Book of John. In the Book of John, we read that the religious leaders picked up stones to kill Jesus when Jesus said, "I AM" (John 8:59 & John 10:30–33).

There are so many similarities between the events concerning Exodus and Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth that can only be explained as miracle intervention by GOD.

Introduction To: The Gospel of Isaiah

Isaiah ended up being sawn in two inside a log. But not before he had succeeded in delivering GOD's messages to us. He became one of the famous major Prophets. These prophecies are taken from the Book of Isaiah and mainly from Chapter 53. They were written about 600 years before Christ appeared. They provide us with a clear picture that the Christ-Messiah must suffer. Christ suffering? Yes. Jesus the Christ had to truly suffer in order to destroy the works of Devil-Satan's death, decay and suffering so that we could be liberated from this existing hell. Hell? Hell yes! Whilst there may be pretty goings-on on nature's surface with all the birds, animals, trees, flowers, oceans etc., take a look closer and you will see the carnage of survival-of-the-fittest with rape, pillage, murder, pain and suffering at every level of life on earth.

Devil-Satan is the, now temporary, ruler of this world (John 14:30) but because of being out-manoeuvred by EHYEH, the reign is fast coming to an end. It is logical to accept the fact that wherever Devil-Satan is, which right now is here on earth, there is hell. Some people choose not to believe in EHYEH because of all the pain and suffering, but the truth is that all our pain and suffering is a consequence of the work of Devil-Satan.

The Good News Gospel is that Jesus has started to destroy and phase out all pain and all suffering. Even Devil-Satan's bone-cancer-in-children is going to be destroyed by Jesus eventually and never seen, or heard of, again. Why not join in the fight, battles and war against Devil-Satan and start applying Holy Spirit written miracle words against every evil infliction? If you choose to accept this mission, you will be carrying out the work and Will of Jesus the Christ (1 John 3:8).

Some of the Jewish leaders, who murdered the Christ-Messiah, tried to delete prophesies from their Scriptures because they were too compelling as evidence that Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth was indeed the Christ-Messiah who was actually described centuries in advance. Whilst Isaiah 53 was never deleted entirely, eventually, it became forbidden to be read in most, if not all, synagogues. According to some scholars, the 17th-century Jewish historian, Raphael Levi, admitted that because Isaiah 53 caused "arguments and great confusion" the rabbis decided the best thing to do was to take the prophecy out of the Haftarah readings in the synagogues. They stop someway through Isaiah 52 and jump straight to Isaiah 54 instead. The official synagogue line today is that Isaiah 53's Suffering Messiah is a metaphor for the Jews who suffered at the hands of the non-Jews. This could be a plausible explanation, if this was the only prophecy, but it isn't. There are hundreds of them, many of which point to the suffering of the Messiah. The banning of Isaiah 53 is a symptom of a hard and uncircumcised heart. Read the Gospel of Isaiah

amongst all the other prophecies yourself and make up your own mind.

Before you do, here is a taster of some of the typical prophecies and predictions included in the *Four Gospels-In-Advance*:

Prophecy Table

All dates are approximate in this table. Experts differ in their opinions, so I have taken the most likely dates. Ancient prophesies in the Holy Bible's Old Testament concerning the appearing of Christ, were used by the Original First Christians to prove that Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth was the Christ-Messiah. Prophecy Made: 580 BC

Prediction Fulfilled: AD 33 by Jesus of Bethlehem and

Nazareth

The Prophecy

Look! My servant will act with wisdom. He will be highly

placed, highly exalted, and highly elevated.

Many stared in amazement at his appearance, which was

disfigured more than any man and his form marred beyond

human likeness.

Likewise, he will startle many nations. Kings will be

speechless in his presence, for they will see what they have

not been told and understand what they have not heard.

Who has put their trust in our message? As for GOD's power,

who has GOD revealed it to?

He will come up like a branch from a tree, like a root from

dry land. He has no status or beauty that would cause us to

consider him. There is nothing in his appearance that would

make us desire him.

He was despised and people avoided him. He was a man destined for pain. He was surrounded by sicknesses. People turned their faces away from him, they considered him to be worth nothing.

He truly took upon himself our sicknesses and carried our pain, but we thought that he was cursed, that GOD had inflicted wounds on him and punished him.

He was pierced for our rebellion. He was crushed for our sins. He was punished so that we could obtain peace. Because of his wounds, we have been healed.

Like sheep, we have all strayed away. Every one of us has turned to go our own way, yet GOD has laid all of our sins on him.

He was abused and allowed himself to receive punishment, but he did not protest against it. He was brought like a lamb to the slaughter. He was like a sheep that is silent when being sheared. He would not open his mouth. He was arrested, taken away and judged.

"I gave my back to the strikers, and my cheeks to those pulling out my beard; I turned and faced their insults and spitting."

Who would have thought that he would be put to death? He was killed because of the sin of my people.

He was buried in a tomb alongside the wicked and the rich were there too in his death, even though he had done nothing violent and had never spoken a lie.

GOD himself was pleased to crush him and willing to make him suffer. GOD made his life a sacrifice for all the wrong we have all done, and because of that, he will have offspring for many days. Through his pleasing work, GOD's Will has been achieved.

He will see, understand, and become completely satisfied because of his pain. My righteous servant will save many people because he has taken on their sins. He has righteous knowledge through what he has learned.

Therefore, I will give him a share among the mighty. He will divide this prize with many, due to the fact he poured out his life in death and he was counted as if he was a sinner. He carried the sins of many people and now intercedes for the rebellious.

Prediction Fulfilment

(Matthew, Mark, Luke & John)

Jesus was taken away to the high priest. All the chief priests, leaders and scribes joined to visit him. The whole council along with the chief priests tried to find people to witness against Jesus, so they could kill him, but could not find anyone. Some gave false testimonies about Jesus, but the testimonies conflicted with each other.

Some false witnesses arose and said, "He said, 'I will destroy this temple built by hand, and in three days' time I will build another one made without hands." Even then, their testimonies conflicted with each other. The high priest arose amongst them, and asked Jesus, "Have you nothing to say to answer them? What exactly are they accusing you of?" But he remained silent and did not answer them. Again, the high priest questioned him, "Are you the Christ, the Son of GOD?" Jesus said, "I am. You will look at the Son of Man placed at the right hand of power and coming upon the clouds in the sky." The high priest ripped his clothing, saying, "Why do we need any more witnesses? You have heard him blaspheme! Do you agree?" Every one of them condemned him to deserve death. A few began to spit on him, covering his face and punching him. They said, "Prophesy!" and the officers slapped him using the palms of their hands.

As soon as it was morning, the chief priests, leaders, scribes, and the whole council, had a meeting. They tied Jesus up and took him away to be given to Pilate. Pilate questioned him, "Are you the King of the Jews?" He answered, "So you say." The chief priests accused him on a number of matters. Pilate again questioned him, "Don't you have an answer? Can you see all the matters they accuse you of?" But Jesus remained silent. Pilate marvelled at this. Pilate questioned the crowd again, "What then should I do to him whom you call the King of the Jews?" They again shouted out, "Crucify him!" Pilate replied, "Why, what wrong has he committed?" But they cried out even louder, "Crucify him!" Pilate, wanting to make the crowd happy, released Barabbas. He then handed over Jesus to be flogged and sent him away to be crucified.

The soldiers led him away inside the court that is known as the Praetorium. Then they summoned the entire cohort. They dressed him up in purple, and after weaving together a crown of thorns, they placed it on his head. They started to salute him and say, "Hail the King of the Jews!" They reedswiped his head, spat on him, then bowing down upon their knees, pretended to worship him. After they had their laugh at his expense, they snatched back the purple robe and dressed him in his own clothing. Then they took him away to crucify him.

In the evening after he had died, along came a rich man from Arimathea called Joseph, who was also a disciple of Jesus. Joseph approached Pilate to request that he give Jesus's body to him. Pilate commanded that the body was to be handed over. Joseph took the body, wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, placed it in his own new tomb (which he had cut out of the rock) then had a large stone rolled over to cover the entrance. Then he left.

On Sunday, very early in the morning, the women visited the tomb. They had prepared and brought spices. They arrived at the tomb but found the stone rolled away. When the women entered the tomb, they did not find the body of Jesus the Christ inside it. Whilst they were trying to work out what was going on here, two men dressed in radiant clothing came and stood next to them.

Whilst the women fell down and buried their faces into the ground out of sheer terror, they were asked the following question by the two men, "Why look for people who are alive amongst those who have died? He is not here; He has risen! Remember what He told you when you were still in Galilee? 'The Son of Man has to be given into the control of sinful men, they will crucify him, then on the third day he will rise up from the dead'."

The Good Confession

The Good Confession is a composite statement about Jesus the Christ written by Ignatius of Antioch. He wrote it within ten years of the death of the Apostle John. He was a friend of Polycarp, a disciple of the Apostle John, and apparently was appointed leader of the community of GOD's people in Antioch (Syria) by the Apostle Peter. This is the earliest and most accurate truth we have about who Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth really was. It's as if the Apostle John, the disciple who Jesus loved (John 21:7), was saying these truths through Ignatius himself. Ignatius was very close to the communities of EHYEH's people in Philadelphia and Smyrna. These two communities were the only two out of seven that did not receive a rebuke from Jesus the Christ (Revelation 1-3):

We agree with the Apostles and believe that there is only one Healer who is made of both flesh and spirit, born and unborn, GOD in the flesh, true life surrounded by death, son of Mary and Son of GOD, initially experiencing suffering then afterwards beyond suffering — Jesus the Christ our RULER.

For our GOD, Jesus the Christ:

- Was conceived in Mary's womb according to the preplanning of GOD and by the Holy Spirit
- Is physically descended from the line of David according to ancestry
- Is the Son of GOD according to the will and power of GOD
- Was born the son of Mary when she was still a virgin
- Ate and drank among us, both before being killed and after being raised up to life again
- Was baptised by John in order that all righteousness might be fulfilled by him
- Was nailed and crucified for us in his physical body under Pontius Pilate and Herod the Tetrarch
- Died in full sight of persons in heaven, on earth, and under the earth
- Was physically and spiritually raised from the dead when his Father raised him up
- Was touched and handled by his disciples after his resurrection. His disciples then saw that he was composed of flesh whilst being spiritually united with the Father at the same time. For this reason, his disciples also treated death with the same contempt.

He suffered all these things for our sakes so that we might be saved and likewise be raised up from the dead by the Father if we exercise trust in Jesus the Christ.

He has raised up a standard for all ages through his resurrection, to rally together his holy and faithful people whether among Jews or non-Jews, in the one body of the Community of GOD's people.
