Scriptures of Unconditional Love

They are called Scriptures of Unconditional Love because GOD is Unconditional Love (1 John 4:16) and these Scriptures will help us to walk in the ways of Unconditional Love. We should live by Unconditional Love because Moses commanded it (Leviticus 19:18) and so did Jesus the Christ (Matthew 22:37-39). There are an initial thirty of these books to be published. Some are still in process but should be ready by the end of 2026. Once they are completed, more will be added.

The Twenty-One Witness books have been updated from their previous titles and translations using the South-London English that I grew up with. I also replaced the word "church" with "community of GOD's people" and "Lord" with "RULER" as these are more accurate translations. These twenty-one were chosen because they do not contradict the Old or New Testaments in any way but rather provide us with a means to interpret the Holy Bible more accurately and with additional knowledge and understanding.

Nobody had ever told me what was going to happen when I submitted my life to Christ on a South-London Street in February 1974, aged 13. I had a physical Holy Spirit experience as an "atomic bomb of joy" exploded in my being. As I walked along the street, it was like I was floating three feet off the ground. That evening, a Spirit person visited me and wrote these words in my heart with light and fire, "Do not rebuke the church". The end result of this encounter are these Scriptures of Unconditional Love.

The Four Gospels-In-Advance

The Gospel of Isaiah
The Gospel of King David
The Gospel of Moses
The Gospel of The Prophets

These are the books of Written Miracles. Ancient prophecies and predictions scattered throughout the Holy Bible's Old Testament concerning the appearance of Christ. These prophecies were made hundreds, some over a thousand, years before Christ appeared. They were all miraculously fulfilled with pin-point accuracy by Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth. There are so many of them that they could only have been put there by Holy Spirit. Certain Jewish scholars, who did not want Jesus to be their Messiah or Christ, started deleting the more obvious prophecies. You can find some of them restored in the books of the twenty-one witnesses. It is best to read the Gospels of Isaiah and King David first as they will strengthen your faith so that your heart can be prepared to receive the teachings and testimonies of the twenty-one witnesses.

The Twenty-One Witnesses

It is like we have twenty-one new witnesses presenting themselves before a court with new evidence and testimonies that GOD is real, and Christ is knowable. Some of these witnesses might have come forward from the era of 'Belonging to the Way' which was from AD 33 (Jesus's physical and spiritual resurrection from the dead) to AD 47 after which time those 'Belonging to the Way' were first called Christians. Most of the other witnesses belong to the pre-church era of the Original First Christians. This era spanned from AD 47 to AD 155 when Polycarp, the Disciple of John the Apostle, was executed for being a Christian by the Roman Empire. The Roman Church filled the vacuum with their own authority and 'brand' and were a powerful influence in starting the new 'church age'. Eventually, the twenty-one witnesses were banned from the New Testament in the fourth century by Emperor Constantine's Roman Church of Christendom, even though these scriptures were originally treasured by Christians of the first and second centuries. Fearing persecution, holders of the books managed to hide them and keep them safe. One thousand two hundred and fifty years later they began to be rediscovered again. Silence broken. Christianity unrestricted. Let them speak. Let us listen.

If they had been allowed to speak and were given their rightful place in the New Testament, they would have acted as salt and light to have a purifying effect on the religious authorities down the centuries. The world would not have experienced the abuses of zealous misguided religious powers. There would have been no crusades, no inquisitions, no witch hunts, no public burnings and no religious persecutions. There would have been no need for European colonialism either as the colonised nations would already be worshipping Christ, having destroyed their gods. The world would have been a better place as the unconditional love of Christ became the new currency that replaced cruelty. The Good Confession would have united the community of GOD's people and all the gods would have been annihilated. There would also have been no need for GOD to send the Qur'an. Having said that, the church has done a vital job in helping to get rid of many gods by either destroying or absorbing them. My hope is that these twentyone witnesses will serve to destroy the remaining gods in the world leaving Devil Satan, who has won the right to remain here, as the sole survivor from the original sin rebellion. Hindus and similar, must abandon all their gods and worship Krishna alone. You can read the books of enlightenment when they have been published, to understand more about this. It is also now time for those churches that have absorbed pagan gods and practices, to get rid of them.

The church's shortcomings can be traced all the way back to AD 154 when Anicetus, Bishop of Rome, refused to accept the Nisan 14 Passover date that Polycarp, disciple of apostle John, and the other apostles observed, regardless of the day of the week it landed on. Anicetus instead kept to what we now know as the Easter dates which should be abandoned in favour of Nisan 14.

The twenty-one witnesses reveal to mankind that all the books of the Holy Bible should be read in the context of GOD versus the gods. In this war, each one of us finds ourselves at one of five stages.

Stage One: Individuals abandon their god(s). It is better to practice

secular atheism than to worship demons.

Stage Two: Acknowledge GOD but don't agree with GOD. Presenting oneself regularly before GOD, either in a church or some other similar gathering will help your case with your Creator.

Stage Three: Agree with GOD but don't obey.

Stage Four: Try your best to obey GOD.

Stage Five: Full submission to GOD. This is perfection.

Introduction

The Witness of Jesus is the third book of EHYEH's Witnesses that belongs to the collection of the twenty-two books of EHYEH's Witnesses, which in turn belong to the collection of thirty books known as the Scriptures of Unconditional Love.

The Witness of Jesus benefits us because it acts as another witness coming forward to testify that GOD is real and knowable and that what the Scriptures tell us about Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth is indeed true. We can walk in a relationship with EHYEH which is the true Name of GOD (Exodus 3:14).

This book should be used alongside other books of *Scriptures of Unconditional Love* and *The SoUL Song* as they all glorify the Name of GOD. You will no longer be in two minds and question in your hearts whether these things are true or not, instead, you will now know, beyond any reasonable or rational doubt, that these things are indeed true and that nothing really exists outside of the truth. All these truths are certain, powerful and established on a sure footing.

You can use *The Witness of Jesus* as the central core of a worship activity. Worship EHYEH either on your own (Matthew 6:6) or with other people. Start with reciting "Draw near to GOD and EHYEH will come close to you"

(James 4:8), then say *The Prayer of Jesus* before singing, reciting or chanting *The SoUL Song*. Then comes the recital where the introduction to *The Witness of Jesus* is read before the whole public (or private) reading of *The Witness of Jesus*.

Don't be too rigid or legalistic but be flexible and open to inspiration from GOD as you might be touched to include or exclude Holy Spirit material as EHYEH moves in your heart. You might be alone or isolated, but if you humbly recite these words you will draw close to GOD who will respond by coming close to you. Keep in touch with EHYEH and GOD will never leave you or forsake you (Hebrews 13:5). You will never be alone ever again. Don't forget to take the opportunity to apply the Holy Spirit Words of substance in *The Witness of Jesus* to anything organic that is ailing, whether human, animal or plant, for there is Holy Spirit Magic material in this miracle Word.

The Spirit of Jesus is EHYEH ASHER EHYEH which is the Name GOD told Moses when asked (Exodus 3:14).

Give us enough bread to eat today.


Forgive us our sin as we have forgiven those who have sinned against us.

Introduction To: The Witness of Jesus

It's true to say that Jesus never actually wrote a gospel. But here we have one hundred and fourteen sayings of Jesus captured in a manuscript. It was discovered near Nag Hammadi in Egypt, in December 1945 among a group of books known as the Nag Hammadi library. Some historians believe the writing was buried to hide it from the dictates of Bishop Athanasius declaring a strict canon of Christian scripture in AD 367. If written by the disciple Thomas (some scholars call it The Gospel of Thomas), then it could be as early as AD 30 however many guess a later date of around AD 150. Whilst half of the sayings are similar to the traditional four Gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John, the other half are unknown. Some scholars speculate they are from a Gnostic tradition, which is why the sayings have been rejected by many churches today. However, there is nothing Gnostic about them. Generally speaking, Gnostics believed that spirit was good, and material was bad. We have seen that this is wrong because spirit Devil-Satan and our enemy angels are the absolute opposite of good. The 114 sayings of Jesus are in harmony with the Four Gospelsin-Advance and therefore must be all good. If good then perfect, for they were spoken by Jesus and therefore Holy Spirit Word.

THE WITNESS OF JESUS

These are the hidden words spoken by the living Jesus and written down by Didymos, Judas Thomas.

Jesus: "Whoever finds the meaning of these words will not know death."

Jesus: "Let him who seeks keep on seeking until he finds. When he finds, he will become disturbed. When he becomes disturbed, he will be amazed, and will gain power over everything."

Jesus: "If those who are leaders say, 'Look, the kingdom is in the sky,' then the birds of the sky will get there before you. If they say to you, 'It is in the sea,' then the fish will get there before you. Instead, the kingdom is both within you and without you. When you come to consciousness of who you really are, then you will be known, and you will become conscious that you are children of the living Father. But if you will not become conscious of who you are, then you are living in poverty and you are poverty."

Jesus: "The old person will not hesitate to ask a little child who is seven days old where life is and will live. For many who are first will be last, and they will become one and the same." Jesus: "Recognise what you can see and what is hidden from you will be revealed to you. There is nothing hidden that will not be revealed."

The Disciples: "Do you want us to fast? How do we pray? Should we give to charity? What are the rules of eating?"

Jesus: "Do not tell lies, and do not do what you hate, because all things are seen in heaven. For there is nothing covered up that will not be revealed, and there is nothing hidden that will remain hidden."

Jesus: "Happy is the lion that a person will eat for that lion becomes human. Sad is the person that the lion will eat for the lion will also become human."

Jesus: "The RULER is like a wise fisherman who cast his net into the sea and drew it up from the sea full of small fish. Among them the wise fisherman found a wholesome large fish. He threw all the small ones back into the sea and easily chose the big fish. He who has ears to hear let him hear!"

Jesus: "Listen, a sower went out to sow. He took a handful of seed and spread it. Some fell on the road, but the birds came and pecked it up. Others fell on the rock, but they didn't take root in the soil and didn't grow up. Other seed fell among thorns which choked the seeds and worms ate it. Others fell on good soil and produced a good crop that yielded sixty times and one hundred and twenty times."

Jesus: "I have cast fire upon the world, and see, I am guarding it until it is blazing."

Jesus: "This heaven will pass away, and the heaven above it will pass away. The dead are not living, and the living will not die. In the days when you ate what is dead, you made it live. When you come to live in the light, what will you do? On the day when you were one, you became two. But when you become two, what will you do?"

The Disciples: "We know that you are going to leave us. Who will become our leader?"

Jesus: "No matter where you are you must go to James the Just. For his sake, heaven and earth came into being."

Jesus: "Compare me to someone and tell me who am I like."

Simon Peter: "You are like a good angel."

Matthew: "You are like a wise philosopher."

Thomas: "Teacher, my mouth is totally unable to utter who you are like."

Jesus: "I am not your teacher. Because you have drunk, you have become drunk from the bubbling spring that I have looked after."

Jesus: "Thomas, there are three words that I want to tell vou."

The Disciples: "What did Jesus say to you?"

Thomas: "If I tell you one of the words he told me, you will stone me, then fire will come out of the stones and burn you up."

Jesus: "If you fast, you will cause sin to come upon you, and if you pray, you will be condemned, and if you give to charity, you will bring evil to your spirits. When you go into any land and travel around the region, if people invite you to stay, eat what they lay before you and heal the sick among them. For what goes into your mouth will not defile you, it is what comes out of your mouth that will defile you."

Jesus: "When you see one who was not born of a woman, throw yourself on your face and worship Him. He is your Father."

Jesus: "Perhaps people think that I have come to bring peace to the earth. They do not realise I have come to bring conflicts upon the earth: fire, sword and war. For there will be five in one house, three against two and two against three, father against son and son against father, and they will stand separately."

Jesus: "I will give you what no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, what no hand has touched and what has never entered into the heart of man."

The Disciples: "Tell us, how will we all end up?"

Jesus: "Have you found the beginning so that now you seek after the end? For where the end is, that is where the beginning is too. Happy is he who is at the beginning, he will know the end and not taste death."

Jesus: "Happy is he who was before he came to be. If you become my disciples and hear what I say, these very stones will become your servants. For there are five trees for you in Paradise which do not change in summer or in winter, and their leaves never fall. Whoever gets to know them will never taste death."

The Disciples: "Tell us what the kingdom of heaven is like."

Jesus: "It is like a mustard seed, the smallest of all seeds, but when it falls on cultivated soil, it produces a great plant and becomes a shelter for the birds in the sky."

Mary: "What are your disciples like?"

Jesus: "They are like little children living in a field that does not belong to them. When the owners of the field come, they will say, 'Give our field back.' They take off their clothes in front of them in order to give it back to them, and they return their field to them. For this reason, I say, if the owner of a house knows that a thief is coming, he will keep watch before the thief arrives and will not let the thief break into his house, his domain, and steal his goods. You then, be on guard against the world. Prepare yourselves with great strength in case the robbers find a way to get to you, for the

difficulties you expect will arrive. Let there be among you a person who has wisdom. When the fruit was ripe, he quickly came carrying a sickle and harvested it. He who has ears to hear let him hear!"

Jesus: "These babies at the breast are like those who enter into the kingdom."

The Disciples: "Shall we enter the kingdom as babies?"

Jesus: "When you make the two into one, and when you make the outside like the inside and the inside like the outside, and the above like below, and when you make male and female into a single one, so that the male with the female will neither be male nor female, when you make eyes instead of an eye, a hand instead of a hand, a foot instead of a foot, a likeness instead of a likeness, then you will enter."

Jesus: "I shall choose you, one out of a thousand and two out of ten thousand, and they will stand as a single one."

The Disciples: "Teach us about the place where you are, for we must seek it."

Jesus: "He who has ears to hear, let him hear! Light is within a person of light, and it lights up the whole world. If it does not give light, there is darkness."

Jesus: "Love your brother as your own soul, guard him like the apple of your eye." Jesus: "You see the splinter in your brother's eye, but you do not see the wood in your own eye. When you remove the wood from your own eye, then you will see clearly to remove the splinter from your brother's eye. If you do not abstain from the world, you will not find the kingdom. If you do not keep the Sabbath as the Sabbath, you will not see the Father."

Jesus: "I stood in the middle of the world and appeared to them in the flesh. I found them all drunk, not one did I find thirsty. My soul suffered for the children of man, because their hearts are blind and they cannot see, for empty they came into the world, and empty they seek to depart from the world. In the meantime, they are drunk. When they cut off their wine, then they will repent."

Jesus: "If the flesh came into being because of spirit, it is a marvel, but if spirit came into being because of the body, that is a marvel of marvels. Yet I marvel at how this great wealth has come to live in this poverty."

Jesus: "Where there are three gods, they are gods. Where there are two or one, I am with him."

Jesus: "No prophet is welcome where he lives; no physician heals those who know him."

Jesus: "A city built on a high hill with fortifications cannot fall, nor can it be hidden."

Jesus: "What you hear in one ear, proclaim from the rooftops to the other ear. After all, no one lights a lamp and places it under a bushel, nor does one hide it. Instead, he places it on a lampstand so that everyone who comes and goes will see its light."

Jesus: "If a blind man leads a blind man, both will fall into a pit."

Jesus: "You cannot enter a strong man's house and take it by force unless you tie his hands first. Then you can rob his house."

Jesus: "Do not worry from morning to evening and from evening to morning what you are going to wear."

The Disciples: "When will you be revealed to us, and when will we see you?"

Jesus: "When you undress without shame then take those clothes and put them under your feet like little children to trample on, then you will see the Son of the Living One and you will have no fear."

Jesus: "Often you have desired to hear these words which I speak to you, and you have no one else to hear them from. Days will come when you will seek me but will not find me."

Jesus: "The Pharisees and the Scribes have taken the keys of knowledge and hidden them. They have not entered, nor have they allowed others to enter who want to. As for you, be wise as serpents and innocent as doves."

Jesus: "A grapevine was planted outside of the Father. Because it did not become established, it was pulled up by its root and destroyed."

Jesus: "He who has something in hand will be given more. He who has nothing, even the little he has will be taken from him."

Jesus: "Be passers-by."

The Disciples: "Who are you to say these things to us?"

Jesus: "You do not recognise who I am from what I say to you. You have become like the Jews, for they love the tree but hate its fruit or love the fruit but hate the tree."

Jesus: "He who blasphemes against the Father will be forgiven, and he who blasphemes against the Son will be forgiven, but he who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven, either on earth or in heaven."

Jesus: "Grapes are not picked from thorns and figs are not gathered from thistles, for they produce no fruit. A good man brings out good from his store, an evil man brings out evil from the wickedness he has stored up in his heart and speaks evil. From the overflow of the heart, he produces evil."

Jesus: "From among those born of women, from Adam to John the Baptist, there is nobody better than John the Baptist who never has to lower his eyes. Yet I have said that whoever among you becomes like a child will know the kingdom and will become better than John."

Jesus: "It is impossible for a man to ride two horses or stretch two bows. And it is impossible for a slave to serve two masters, otherwise he will honour one of them and dishonour the other. A man does not drink old wine and then want to drink new wine. New wine is not poured into old wineskins, or they might burst, and old wine is not poured into new wineskins because it might spoil. An old patch is not sewn onto a new garment, otherwise it would tear."

Jesus: "If two make peace with one another in the same house, they will say to the mountain, 'Move!' and it will move."

Jesus: "Happy are you if you stand alone and are chosen, for you will find the kingdom. You have come from it and you will return to it."

Jesus: "If they ask you, 'Where have you come from?' say to them, 'We have come from the light, the place where the light came into being by itself, became established and revealed itself through its image.' If they ask you, 'Is it you?' say, 'We are His children, we are the chosen of the Living Father.' If they ask you, 'What is the sign that your Father is in you?' say 'It is movement and rest'."

The Disciples: "When will the rest for the dead happen, and when will the new world come?"

Jesus: "What you are waiting for has already happened, but you do not know it."

The Disciples: "Twenty-four prophets spoke in Israel, and they all spoke of you."

Jesus: "You have left out the one alive before you now and have only spoken of the dead ones."

The Disciples: "Is circumcision beneficial or not?"

Jesus: "If it were beneficial, their father would produce children already circumcised from their mother. Instead, the true circumcision in spirit is absolutely useful."

Jesus: "Happy are the poor for theirs is the kingdom of heaven."

Jesus: "He who does not hate his father and mother cannot become my disciple, and he who does not hate his brothers and sisters, and carry his execution wood as I do, is not worthy of me."

Jesus: "He who knows this world has found a corpse, and he who finds a corpse is better than the world."

Jesus: "The Father's kingdom is like a man who sowed seed. His enemy came at night and sowed weeds amongst the good seed. The man told the labourers not to pull up the weeds, he said to them, 'You might pull up some of the wheat with the weeds.' On harvest day the weeds will be easily seen then pulled up and burned."

Jesus: "Happy is the one who has suffered, he has found life."

Jesus: "Seek the Living One whilst you are alive, otherwise you might die then try to seek the Living One but be unable to do so."

He saw a Samaritan carrying a lamb on his way to Judea.

Jesus: "Why is that person carrying that lamb?"

The Disciples: "To kill it and eat it."

Jesus: "He will not be eating it whilst it is alive, but only after he has killed it and it has become a corpse."

The Disciples: "Otherwise he cannot do it."

Jesus: "Likewise, you must find a place for yourselves to rest otherwise you might become a carcass and get eaten."

Jesus: "Two will lie on a bed; one will die, the other live."

Salome: "Who are you mister? You have been on my bed and eaten from my table as if you are from the One."

Jesus: "I am He who comes from the Complete. I have been given some of the things of my Father."

Salome: "I am your disciple."

Jesus: "Therefore, if one is whole, one will be filled with light, but if one is divided, one will be filled with darkness."

Jesus: "I tell my mysteries to those who are worthy of my mysteries. Do not let your left hand know what the right hand is doing."

Jesus: "There was a rich man who had a lot of money. He said to himself, 'I will invest my money to sow, reap, plant and fill my storehouses with produce so that I will have no need of anything.' This was the plan in his heart, but that very same night he died. He who has ears to hear let him hear!"

Jesus: "A man wanted to host certain guests. After he had prepared the dinner, he sent his servant to invite the guests. The servant went to the first one and said to that one, 'My master has invited you.' That one replied, 'Some merchants owe me money and are coming over tonight. I must go and give them instructions on how to pay me. Please excuse me from the dinner.' The servant went to the next one and said to that one, 'My master has invited you.' That one replied, 'I have just bought a property and need to spend the day there, I will run out of time.' The servant went to another and said to that one, 'My master invites you.' That one said

to the servant, 'My friend is getting married and I have to arrange the celebrations. I can't come so please excuse me from the dinner.' The servant went to the next one and said to that one, 'My master invites you.' That one said to the servant, 'I have bought a large estate and I must go to collect the rent. I cannot come so please excuse me.' The servant returned to his master and said, 'Everyone that you invited to the dinner wishes to be excused from it.' The master then instructed his servant, 'Go around the streets outside and find people to bring back for the dinner.' Businessmen and dealers will not enter the Father's abode."

Jesus: "A certain person owned a vineyard and rented it out to some farmers, so they could work it and he could collect the produce from them. He sent his servant to the farmers to receive the produce of the vineyard from them. They seized him and beat him nearly to death. The servant returned and reported this to his master. His master said, 'Perhaps they didn't recognise him.' So, he sent another servant and the farmers also beat him up. Then the master sent his son and said, 'Surely they will show my son some respect.' But because the farmers knew that he was the heir to the vineyard, they seized him and killed him. He who has ears to hear let him hear!"

Jesus: "Show me the stone which the builders rejected; it is the cornerstone."

Jesus: "He who knows all but does not know who they are, lacks everything."

Jesus: "Blessed is he who persecutes themselves in their own heart for he has come to know the Father in truth. Blessed is he who is hungry for his stomach will be filled."

Jesus: "If you bring out what is within you, what you have will save you. If you do not bring out what is within you, what you do not bring out will destroy you."

Jesus: "I will destroy this house, and no one will be able to rebuild it."

Man: "Tell my brothers to divide my father's possessions with me."

Jesus: "Who made me a divider?"

Jesus (to his disciples): "I am not a divider, am I?"

Jesus: "The harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few, so urge the RULER to send workers into the fields."

Jesus: "RULER, there are many around the well, but there is nothing in the well."

Jesus: "There are many standing at the door, but only those standing alone will enter the bridal suite."

Jesus: "The Father's kingdom is like a merchant with a supply of goods who found a pearl. That trader was wise; he

sold his goods and purchased the pearl for himself. You also should seek treasure that lasts and is indestructible. Moths do not come near it and worms do not destroy it."

Jesus: "I am the light that is above all. I am all. All came out from me and to me, all will come. Chop a bit of wood and I am there. Pick up the stone and you will find me there."

Jesus: "Why did you go to the desert? To see a reed shaken by the wind? To see a person dressed in fine clothing like your kings and powerful men? They are dressed in fine clothes yet are unable to understand the truth."

Woman: "Blessed is the womb that bore you and the breasts that fed you."

Jesus: "Blessed are those who have heard the Father's word and have kept it in truth. For days will come when you will say, 'Blessed is the womb that has not conceived and the breasts that have not given milk'."

Jesus: "He who has found the world has found a dead body and he who has found the dead body is superior to the world."

Jesus: "Let him who has become rich become king and let him who has power let go of it."

Jesus: "He who is close to me is close to the fire and he who is away from me is away from the kingdom."

Jesus: "Images are seen by man, but the light within them is hidden in the image of the light of the Father. He will reveal himself, but his image will remain hidden by his light."

Jesus: "When you see your own likeness, you become happy. But when you see your likeness that came into existence before you which does not die or becomes seen, then how will you be able to bear it?"

Jesus: "Adam came into being from a great power and a great wealth, but he was not worthy of you. If he had been worthy, he would not have tasted death."

Jesus: "Foxes have holes and birds have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay down and rest."

Jesus: "Sad is the body that depends on a body and sad is the soul that depends on these two."

Jesus: "Angels and prophets will come to you and give you what already belongs to you. You, in turn, should give them what you have, and say to yourselves, 'When will they come and take what belongs to them?'."

Jesus: "Why do you wash the outside of the cup? Do you not know that he who created the inside created the outside as well?"

Jesus: "Come to me, for my yoke is light and my rulership is gentle, and you will find rest for yourselves."

Men: "Tell us who you are so that we may believe in you."

Jesus: "You look into the face of heaven and earth, yet you do not know the one who stands before you, and you do not know how to test and find out."

Jesus: "Seek and you will find. Yet the issues you raised some time ago, and which I did not answer you about, now I want to tell you, but you no longer want to hear."

Jesus: "Do not give what is holy to dogs in case they throw it on the dung-heap. Do not throw pearls to swine in case they trample them into the mud."

Jesus: "He who seeks finds, and to him who knocks, the door will be opened."

Jesus: "If you have any money, do not lend it out with interest. Instead, give it to someone who can't pay you back."

Jesus: "The Father's kingdom is like a woman who took a little yeast, kneaded it into some dough then made some large loaves of bread. He who has ears to hear let him hear."

Jesus: "The Father's kingdom is like a woman carrying a jar full of grain. As she walked along the road far away, the handle of the jar broke and the grain spilled behind her along the road. She didn't know it as she hadn't noticed the accident. When she got home, she put the jar down and found it empty."

Jesus: "The Father's kingdom is like a certain man who wanted to kill a powerful man. He drew his sword in his own home and thrust it into the wall to find out if his hand was strong enough. Then he went and killed the powerful man."

The Disciples: "Your brothers and your mother are waiting outside."

Jesus: "Those who do the will of my Father are my brothers and my mother. It is they who will enter my Father's kingdom."

Men (after showing Jesus a gold coin): "Caesar's servants demand taxes from us."

Jesus: "Give to Caesar what belongs to Caesar, give to GOD what belongs to GOD and give to me what belongs to me."

Jesus: "He who does not hate his father and mother in the same way that I do, cannot be my disciple. He who does not unconditionally love his father and mother as I do, cannot be my disciple. For my mother gave me illusion, but my true mother gave me life."

Jesus: "Sad will be the Pharisees because they are like a dog that sleeps in the oxen's manger. The dog does not eat and neither does it let the oxen eat."

Jesus: "Blessed is he who knows where the thieves will come in because he can get ready for them. He can organise his house, then arm himself before the assault." The Disciples: "Let us fast and pray today."

Jesus: "What have I done wrong? How have I been wronged? Usually, people fast and pray after the groom has left the bridal suite."

Jesus: "He who knows the father and the mother will be called the child of a prostitute."

Jesus: "When you make the two into one, you will become sons of man. When you say, 'Mountain, be moved' it will move."

Jesus: "The kingdom is like a shepherd who had a hundred sheep. The best one strayed. He left the ninety-nine sheep and looked for it until he found it. After his hard work, he said to the sheep, 'I care for you more than the ninety-nine'."

Jesus: "He who drinks from my mouth will become like me. I myself will become him and the things that are hidden will be shown to him."

Jesus: "The Father's kingdom is like a man who was unaware of a treasure hidden in his field. After he died, he left it to his son. His son was also unaware of the treasure. He inherited the field then sold it. The purchaser ploughed the field and found the treasure. He then began to lend money at interest to whomever he wanted."

Jesus: "He who finds the world and becomes rich should renounce the world."

Jesus: "The heavens and the earth will be rolled up in your sight. He who lives from the Living One will not taste death."

Jesus: "He who finds himself is greater than the world."

Jesus: "Sad is the flesh that depends on the soul. Sad is the soul that depends on the flesh."

The Disciples: "When will the kingdom come?"

Jesus: "It will not come by you waiting around for it. It won't be a matter of saying 'here it is or there it is.' Instead, the Father's kingdom is already spread throughout the earth, but people can't see it."

Simon Peter: "Mary should leave us because females do not deserve this life."

Jesus: "Listen, I personally will help her become male so that she will also be a living Spirit just like you males. After all, every female who becomes male will enter the Kingdom of Heaven."

The History of Jesus

Many people believe that the Son of GOD became Jesus. That the Son is of the same substance as GOD. That the Son is the second person of the Trinity to the Father. That the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity. One GOD in three divine persons all co-equal and co-eternal. There are some Trinity-type statements in both the New Testament and the Scriptures of Unconditional Love where we are instructed to baptise in the Name of the Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19). Other verses Trinitarians' use are:

John 10:30 – I and My Father are one.

John 1:1 – In the beginning was the Word, the Word was with GOD and the Word was GOD.

Colossians 2:9 – The whole fullness of GOD lives in Christ's human body.

Others believe that there is more than one Son of GOD and Jesus is one of many. Some say that the Son of GOD was created, and some say that the Son of GOD and the archangel Michael are the same person. Another theory is that Jesus was a mere man upon whom the Spirit of Christ ascended for a while and later departed. Still others believe Jesus was a phantom and not really made of flesh and blood at all. Most of these do not believe the Son of GOD was the

same substance as GOD. They reckon the Son is of like, similar, or different substance but not the same substance. Unitarians use the following verses to disprove the Trinity:

Deuteronomy 6:4 – The RULER our GOD is one RULER.

Matthew 24:36 – However no person knows the day or the hour. The angels in heaven do not know, the Son does not know, only the Father knows.

John 14:29b – ...the Father is greater than I.

Towards the end of the third century there was a strong debate which became known as the Arian controversy. Arius, who was very popular and had the majority sway amongst Christians at that time, believed in the unique oneness of GOD that excluded the Son and Holy Spirit in essence. He believed that the Son of GOD was the highest of GOD's angels who was sent to earth to become Jesus the Christ. Athanasius opposed Arius and argued the case for the Trinity. Athanasius defeated Arius in the debate by stating that if the Son was not GOD, then how could he redeem the world? Since then, the Trinity has become the most popular dogma as it is today. So, was Athanasius really correct about the Trinity, or was Arius really right with his Highest Angel? Both were wrong.

Having spent decades searching for the answer to this mystery that has bewildered people down the ages, I have decided to present my findings here and now. Neither the

Holy Bible nor the Scriptures of Unconditional Love confirm or deny conclusively who the Son of GOD really is. The answer lies with other witnesses not found in traditional Bibles. GOD has revealed additional information in other revelations from heaven for us to use, in conjunction with the Bible, to complete the puzzle.

So, here is the history of the Son of GOD, compiled from the Holy Bible, the Scriptures of Unconditional Love, the Qur'an, the Bhagavad Gita and Philip's research:

BC Jesus (Before Christ Jesus)

- IN THE BEGINNING WAS GOD.
- 2. GOD expanded and brought into existence WISDOM.
- 3. WISDOM was the first to be brought into existence.
- 4. The FATHER of WISDOM is GOD.
- WISDOM is the Son of GOD.
- This Son of GOD is different from any subsequent sons of GOD because WISDOM is both the same substance as GOD and the same Will as GOD.
- 7. Subsequent sons of GOD are either independent Will from GOD or devoid of Will.
- GOD expanded, and through the Son, brought into existence spirit persons, spirit beings and spiritual dimensions.

- 9. The spirit persons and spirit beings are made out of the same substance as GOD.
- 10. Spirit persons have independent Will.
- 11. Spirit beings have no Will.
- 12. GOD expanded through the Son and created material of the same substance as GOD.
- 13. Multiverses were made of material including the earth.
- 14. GOD filled the earth with many forms of life.
- 15. GOD said to the Son, "Let us make humankind in our image, in our likeness, so they will rule over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, the animals, the whole earth and over all the creatures that crawl on the earth" (Genesis 1:26).
- 16. Everything that had been expanded or made was good and was perfect life. There was no death in it.
- 17. GOD said, "You angels, I am creating a human being from clay and moulded mud. When I have formed him, and breathed into him of My Spirit, you must all bow down before him."
- 18. So GOD created and shaped them, and the angels bowed down, that is, all of them except Lucifer-Iblees (Satan) who refused and rebelled. Satan had become proud, envious and disloyal.

- 19. Satan won the right to rule over the earth by deceiving and manipulating man to hand over rulership of the earth.
- 20. War broke out in heaven. Michael and his angels fought Satan and his angels.
- 21. Death entered the material creation.
- 22. Man lost paradise and was imprisoned on the earth which now had death in it. Satan ruled the earth. The war ravaged the earth and the multiverses.
- 23. GOD never abandoned man but sent prophets, messengers and messages from heaven down through the ages.
- 24. Most of GOD's prophets and messengers were killed. Many messages were lost, destroyed or corrupted. Some messages got through.
- 25. GOD had thought up a great and indescribable plan to destroy death and restore everything material that had been corrupted.
- 26. The plan was first shared with His Son alone.
- 27. The plan was then shared with us through the messages that had got through. These messages are the *Gospels-In-Advance*.
- 28. Only the wise could decipher the messages as they were obscured to hide them from GOD's enemies.

- 29. The plan was for GOD to give up His own Son as a ransom for us:
 - The Holy One for sinners
 - The Innocent One for the guilty
 - The Just One for the unjust
 - The Incorruptible One for the corruptible
 - The Immortal One for the mortal.

AD Jesus (Anno Domini Jesus or to translate from the Latin to English – In the year of our RULER Jesus)

- 1. We remembered Mary who guarded her chastity: We breathed into her from Our Spirit, and We caused her to be a sign for everyone.
- 2. The Angel: "Mary, Allah has made you pure and chosen you to be special over all the women in the world. Devote yourself to your RULER by bowing down and bending the knee along with the righteous. Allah sends you the good news of His Word. His name is the Christ, Jesus, son of Mary."
- Mary: "My RULER, how can I have a baby when I am a virgin?"
- 4. The Angel: "Allah causes to be whatever He wants so it will be done. He only has to say the word 'Be' and it happens. He will teach him the Scripture, Wisdom, the Law and the Gospel."

- 5. When she had given birth, she came upon her people whilst carrying the child.
- 6. The People: "Mary you have sinned badly. Your father was not a bad man and your mother was not a whore."
- 7. Except for the wise few who knew the Gospel-In-Advance, people thought that Mary had been made pregnant by another man instead of Joseph to whom she was pledged to be married.
- 8. Joseph thought that too but, being a good man who did not want to expose Mary to public disgrace, planned to divorce her quietly. Only cousin Elizabeth knew otherwise because she did the virgin test on Mary but they both kept quiet about it and let GOD's Will be done.
- 9. An angel came to Joseph in a dream and explained the situation to him. Joseph then took Mary home to be his wife and they had the child.
- 10. As Jesus grew, he looked exactly like Joseph. GOD had not only sent the Spirit of His Son into Mary's womb but had also crafted Mary's egg to look like Joseph.
- 11. The people were bewildered. The child was, without any doubt, Joseph's son after all. But they did not understand the reason why Joseph, a man of righteousness and integrity, wanted to divorce Mary during Mary's pregnancy with Joseph's son.

- 12. Whilst going through this world Jesus learned how to do GOD's Will perfectly. Jesus lived blamelessly and without any sin.
- 13. We too can follow Jesus' example and teaching. We too can learn how to go through this world doing GOD's Will, avoiding sin, living blamelessly and being perfect.
- 14. After going through this world as planned, Jesus' appointed time to die arrived. Just as the Gospels-In-Advance, the New Testament and the Scriptures of Unconditional Love witness to us, Jesus was unjustly murdered, and his physical body died.
- 15. Jesus' dead body lay in the tomb for three days and nights. Jesus' Spirit went to a prison under the earth inhabited by spirits that were held when they died in the Flood of Noah. Jesus preached to them the Good News Gospel.
- Because Jesus committed no sin, which is the power of death, death could not hold onto him but had to let him go.
- 17. On the way back to his dead body, he took the keys of death and hell "Do not be afraid; I am the Start and the End. I am the Living One. I was dead, but look and see, I am alive forever and ever. Let it be. And I hold the keys to death and hell" (Rev. 1:17–18).
- 18. Jesus' Spirit re-entered his dead body. Death left Jesus's dead body and only life was there.

- 19. An angel rolled away the stone that covered the tomb entrance. It was a legal act ordered from heaven. Jesus could have made the stone move away with a command or simply walk through it. The death in the stone and the death in the material creation were no barrier to the death-less body of Jesus.
- 20. There is only one place in the whole of the material creation where there is no death. That place is the human physical body of Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth. That material place with no death in it is located in heaven, sitting at the right-hand side of GOD.
- 21. Because Jesus has defeated death and hell, he only has to give his Word and all the material creation will be refreshed with no death in it. Scriptures of Unconditional Love calls this the phasing-out of death. Jesus will destroy death in phases.

WISDOM - The Spirit of Jesus

Proverbs Chapter 8

WISDOM calls us. Understanding raises her voice. Along the road's high places where paths intersect, she stands out. At the City gates and other entrances, she cries aloud:

"People, I appeal to you. I raise my voice to all mankind. You simple ones, go and get understanding of WISDOM. You foolish ones, get some sense.

"Listen, for I have things of great worth to say. When I speak, I say what is true and correct because my words hate evil. Every word that flows from my mouth is just and right, there is nothing wrong or false in them. They are clear to those who have understanding and plain for those who find knowledge. Take my instruction instead of silver, my knowledge instead of pure gold. WISDOM is better than rubies and nothing people desire can compare with her.

"I, WISDOM live with prudence, I own knowledge and discretion. To deeply respect the RULER is to hate evil. I hate pride, arrogance, evil ways behaviour and crooked words. Good judgement belongs to me and sound WISDOM. I am understanding and power is mine. By me kings, reign and rulers pass just laws. I love them who love me, and those who seek me will find me. Riches and

honour are with me along with wealth that lasts and righteousness. My fruit is better than the finest gold, my dividend greater than the best silver. I follow the way of righteousness and walk in the paths of justice in order to pour wealth on those who love me and to fill their treasuries.

"The RULER made me the beginning of his way, the first of his works of old. I was appointed before the world was, from the very beginning, before the start of anything. I was born before there were any seas or any springs pouring out water. I was born before the mountains and hills were settled in their places and before he made the earth, its fields or any kind of dust in the world. I was there when he positioned the heavens and marked out the horizon's curve over the deep sea. I was there when he established the clouds above and strengthened the fountains of the deep, when he decreed the sea have limits so the waters would not break his command and when he established the Earth's foundations.

"Back then I was the craftsman at his side. I was his daily delight always rejoicing in his presence. I played everywhere on his Earth where people lived and thoroughly enjoyed being with them.

"Therefore, children, listen to me; happy are those who keep my ways.

"Listen to my instruction and be wise; do not reject it. Happy will be the person who listens to me, watching for me at my gate every day, and waiting outside my door." "For whoever finds me finds life and will receive favour from the RULER. But whoever ignores me harms themselves because anyone who hates me loves death."

In the fourth Gospel-In-Advance, *The Gospel of The Prophets*, you will see miracle prophecies concerning Christ that are written in every one of the thirty-nine books of the Old Testament. If you allow Holy Spirit to open your eyes to the truth, you will see Christ throughout the entire Scriptures. Christ is called a variety of names including King, Priest, GOD, RULER, Angel, Man, Captain, Stone and Son.

The Davis Particle

On 23 February 1974, whilst aged thirteen, Philip Davis discovered the *Life Particle*. Being a precocious schoolboy, he promptly named it the *Davis Particle* after himself. No one else took any notice or cared less, so he kept it quiet until now. To be more accurate, Davis was bomb blasted by it. He described it as if an atomic bomb of joy had exploded inside and over him.

It was a physical happening. His feeling, sight and hearing were temporarily altered because of it. It also arrived with the experience of floating in the air and utmost euphoria. From that moment onwards, Philip decided to find out more about the *Davis Particle*. His discoveries made so far, include the following observations:

- 1. It comes from *Dimension Eternity*.
- 2. It originates as pure life.
- 3. If it enters our material world on a non-permanent basis it remains unchanged.
- 4. When it enters our material world permanently, it transforms.
- 5. It transforms by being partially invaded by death.
- 6. It then becomes a life-death particle.

- 7. Both the life and death parts have their own intelligence.
- 8. The life part moves to create, renew, repair and heal.
- 9. The death part causes decay, deterioration and disease. It acts a bit like a cancer or a parasite.
- 10. It's the elementary particle and the smallest sub-atomic particle in existence.
- 11. In the previous material world, there was no death particle.
- 12. In our new material world, the life-death particle is everywhere material.
- This was caused by an historical catastrophic event that transformed everything material throughout the multiverses.
- 14. There were subsequent catastrophic events including those which wiped out dinosaurs and ice-age creatures.
- 15. Both the life and death parts of the particle can be made more active through external factors.
- 16. People like you and me are the main activators.
- 17. Particle activation is determined by people's actions, words, thoughts and attitudes.
- 18. A good example of the movement of the life part of the *Davis Particle* would be the physical healing of Ray and Len as described in *The Gospel of King David*.

- 19. An example of the movement of the death part of the *Davis Particle* would be sickness and disease including harmful virus and bacteria.
- 20. Atoms, first invented in 500 BC, are made of protons, neutrons and electrons. Protons and neutrons are made of quarks. Quarks and electrons are not the fundamental elementary particles that many scientists first thought they are made out of *Davis Particles*.
- 21. *The Davis Particle* is the building block for all matter and anti-matter whether quarks, leptons, gauge bosons, scalar bosons, dark matter or dark energy.

There are two sets of rules recognised in physics to explain the behaviour of the universe:

- 1. Relativity for the larger universe and beyond.
- 2. Quantum Theory for the world of the very small such as sub-atomic particles.

The Law of Relativity determines that nothing can outrace the speed of light. Quantum Theory determines some particles can.

Certain pairs of sub-atomic particles have an intelligence that communicate with each other at the same time, even though relatively speaking, they may be trillions of miles apart. One example would be; when a ball in New Zealand starts to spin at a certain speed and in a certain direction, another ball located in Spain simultaneously starts spinning

in the opposite direction at exactly the same speed. This was proved in 1997 at the University of Geneva when protons were sent seven miles in separate directions. When one of them was interfered with, it caused an immediate response in the other. No scientist has explained how this happens. Davis does.

One scientist who did not like the fact that one particle could influence another trillions of miles away, was Albert Einstein. It violated the special theory of relativity. He did not like the idea that GOD has created a universe where some things are unfathomable. Perhaps this was why, so it is claimed, that he was intrigued with the Bhagavad Gita. He probably realised the answers lay far from this world. Einstein devoted much of the second half of his life to tie together the two sets of rules (above) by trying to discover a Grand Unified Theory, but he did not succeed. Davis did:

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with GOD, and the Word was GOD. In the beginning he was with GOD. All things came to exist through him, and without him nothing was made that was made (John 1:1-3).

Let us make humankind in our image, in our likeness, so they will rule over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, the animals, the whole earth and over all the creatures that crawl on the earth. So, GOD created mankind in his own image, in the image of GOD he created him; male and female he created them. GOD blessed them: GOD said to

them, "Be fruitful, increase in number, fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky and over every living creature that crawl on the earth" (Genesis 1:26-28).

Because of Davis's discovery, we can now understand that all sub-atomic particles and their various fields are actually already united in one Grand Unified Field. They were all made by the Son of GOD and are still being made by him. The laws of relativity and quantum theory are unified at this very moment and have been since the re-creation of our material world and the multiverses. Everything material, whether at the sub-atomic particle level or the larger universal level, may well all be intelligent life-forms that can communicate with each-other just like the protons did. They can also be subdued, manipulated or moved by mankind. This has been proven with unfathomable physical healings and illogical supernatural happenings.

The thirty books of *Scriptures of Unconditional Love* help explain the unfathomable and supernatural. They serve as scientific papers for people to discover new possibilities and avenues that will help mankind make a quantum leap forward in truth, good and right. Davis hopes that mankind will apply this breakthrough in knowledge to move the *Davis Particle* and cause a wave of healing, repair and unconditional Love throughout our planet. As fifteen-year-old Gitanjali Rao (Time's Kid of 2020), said, "The pursuit of science is an essential act of kindness...Anybody can do science."

The Good Confession

We agree with the Apostles and believe that there is only one Healer who is made of both flesh and spirit, born and unborn, GOD in the flesh, true life surrounded by death, son of Mary and Son of GOD, initially experiencing suffering then afterwards beyond suffering — Jesus the Christ our RULER.

For our GOD, Jesus the Christ:

- Was conceived in Mary's womb according to the preplanning of GOD and by the Holy Spirit
- Is physically descended from the line of David according to ancestry
- Is the Son of GOD according to the will and power of GOD
- Was born the son of Mary when she was still a virgin
- Ate and drank among us, both before being killed and after being raised up to life again
- Was baptised by John in order that all righteousness might be fulfilled by him
- Was nailed and crucified for us in his physical body under Pontius Pilate and Herod the Tetrarch
- Died in full sight of persons in heaven, on earth, and under the earth

- Was physically and spiritually raised from the dead when his Father raised him up
- Was touched and handled by his disciples after his resurrection. His disciples then saw that he was composed of flesh whilst being spiritually united with the Father at the same time. For this reason, his disciples also treated death with the same contempt.

He suffered all these things for our sakes so that we might be saved and likewise be raised up from the dead by the Father if we exercise trust in Jesus the Christ.

He has raised up a standard for all ages through his resurrection, to rally together his holy and faithful people whether among Jews or non-Jews, in the one body of the Community of GOD's people.
