Scriptures of Unconditional Love

They are called Scriptures of Unconditional Love because GOD is Unconditional Love (1 John 4:16) and these Scriptures will help us to walk in the ways of Unconditional Love. We should live by Unconditional Love because Moses commanded it (Leviticus 19:18) and so did Jesus the Christ (Matthew 22:37-39). There are an initial thirty of these books to be published. Some are still in process but should be ready by the end of 2026. Once they are completed, more will be added.

The Twenty-One Witness books have been updated from their previous titles and translations using the South-London English that I grew up with. I also replaced the word "church" with "community of GOD's people" and "Lord" with "RULER" as these are more accurate translations. These twenty-one were chosen because they do not contradict the Old or New Testaments in any way but rather provide us with a means to interpret the Holy Bible more accurately and with additional knowledge and understanding.

Nobody had ever told me what was going to happen when I submitted my life to Christ on a South-London Street in February 1974, aged 13. I had a physical Holy Spirit experience as an "atomic bomb of joy" exploded in my being. As I walked along the street, it was like I was floating three feet off the ground. That evening, a Spirit person visited me and wrote these words in my heart with light and fire, "Do not rebuke the church". The end result of this encounter are these Scriptures of Unconditional Love.

The Four Gospels-In-Advance

The Gospel of Isaiah
The Gospel of King David
The Gospel of Moses
The Gospel of The Prophets

These are the books of Written Miracles. Ancient prophecies and predictions scattered throughout the Holy Bible's Old Testament concerning the appearance of Christ. These prophecies were made hundreds, some over a thousand, years before Christ appeared. They were all miraculously fulfilled with pin-point accuracy by Jesus of Bethlehem and Nazareth. There are so many of them that they could only have been put there by Holy Spirit. Certain Jewish scholars, who did not want Jesus to be their Messiah or Christ, started deleting the more obvious prophecies. You can find some of them restored in the books of the twenty-one witnesses. It is best to read the Gospels of Isaiah and King David first as they will strengthen your faith so that your heart can be prepared to receive the teachings and testimonies of the twenty-one witnesses.

The Twenty-One Witnesses

It is like we have twenty-one new witnesses presenting themselves before a court with new evidence and testimonies that GOD is real, and Christ is knowable. Some of these witnesses might have come forward from the era of 'Belonging to the Way' which was from AD 33 (Jesus's physical and spiritual resurrection from the dead) to AD 47 after which time those 'Belonging to the Way' were first called Christians. Most of the other witnesses belong to the pre-church era of the Original First Christians. This era spanned from AD 47 to AD 155 when Polycarp, the Disciple of John the Apostle, was executed for being a Christian by the Roman Empire. The Roman Church filled the vacuum with their own authority and 'brand' and were a powerful influence in starting the new 'church age'. Eventually, the twenty-one witnesses were banned from the New Testament in the fourth century by Emperor Constantine's Roman Church of Christendom, even though these scriptures were originally treasured by Christians of the first and second centuries. Fearing persecution, holders of the books managed to hide them and keep them safe. One thousand two hundred and fifty years later they began to be rediscovered again. Silence broken. Christianity unrestricted. Let them speak. Let us listen.

If they had been allowed to speak and were given their rightful place in the New Testament, they would have acted as salt and light to have a purifying effect on the religious authorities down the centuries. The world would not have experienced the abuses of zealous misguided religious powers. There would have been no crusades, no inquisitions, no witch hunts, no public burnings and no religious persecutions. There would have been no need for European colonialism either as the colonised nations would already be worshipping Christ, having destroyed their gods. The world would have been a better place as the unconditional love of Christ became the new currency that replaced cruelty. The Good Confession would have united the community of GOD's people and all the gods would have been annihilated. There would also have been no need for GOD to send the Qur'an. Having said that, the church has done a vital job in helping to get rid of many gods by either destroying or absorbing them. My hope is that these twentyone witnesses will serve to destroy the remaining gods in the world leaving Devil Satan, who has won the right to remain here, as the sole survivor from the original sin rebellion. Hindus and similar, must abandon all their gods and worship Krishna alone. You can read the books of enlightenment when they have been published, to understand more about this. It is also now time for those churches that have absorbed pagan gods and practices, to get rid of them.

The church's shortcomings can be traced all the way back to AD 154 when Anicetus, Bishop of Rome, refused to accept the Nisan 14 Passover date that Polycarp, disciple of apostle John, and the other apostles observed, regardless of the day of the week it landed on. Anicetus instead kept to what we now know as the Easter dates which should be abandoned in favour of Nisan 14.

The twenty-one witnesses reveal to mankind that all the books of the Holy Bible should be read in the context of GOD versus the gods. In this war, each one of us finds ourselves at one of five stages.

Stage One: Individuals abandon their god(s). It is better to practice

secular atheism than to worship demons.

Stage Two: Acknowledge GOD but don't agree with GOD. Presenting oneself regularly before GOD, either in a church or some other similar gathering will help your case with your Creator.

Stage Three: Agree with GOD but don't obey.

Stage Four: Try your best to obey GOD.

Stage Five: Full submission to GOD. This is perfection.

Forgive us our sin as we have forgiven those who



The Community of God's People

The original Greek word for church is Kuriakos which is only used twice in the *New Testament*. Kuriakos means "of the RULER" (which refers to anyone who was known as a RULER). Kuriakon means the "RULER's house" and was translated into Old English as Cirice and became Chirche.

Ecclesia, on the other hand, appears over 100 times in the *New Testament* which means, "The political assembly of citizens of an ancient Greek state". Since Jesus stated, "*My Kingdom is not of this world*," the Apostles had in mind "The assembly of citizens of the Kingdom of God" which the books of **The New Testament Part Two calls** "*The Community of God's People*."

As stated before, the first Christians did not meet in church buildings. The first Christians themselves were the "Ecclesia" being the community of God's people – a living and breathing "Ecclesia."

The "House of God" is not a building. The House of God is people belonging to the community of God's people whether individual or together.

Introduction To: The Witness of The Twelve Apostles

When was it written?

AD 64? Experts date it any time after AD 50. In its latest form it is combined with another document called *The Two Ways of Life and Death* and most experts believe it was last edited and stitched together around AD 150. The reason for an early date is because there are only two tiers of leadership being overseers (bishops or elders) and assistant overseers (deacons) and there were still travelling apostles and prophets. My theory is that In AD 64 the community of God's people needed an operation manual when meeting in smaller groups due to Nero's persecution. It then became a standard manual for the use of the smaller rural communities of God's people.

Where was it written?

Rome. Some experts believe it was stitched together in AD 150 in Alexandria in Egypt.

Who wrote it?

Christians of Rome.

Why was it written?

Emperor Nero sets Rome on fire, plays the fiddle whilst Rome burns and blames the fire on the Christians whom he then persecutes with much cruelty. Because it was too dangerous to gather together as a single community of God's people, the Christians split into smaller and more discreet groups. They needed an instruction manual because the leaders were either killed (as were Peter and Paul) or were spread too thin. It could well be that this manual was either authorised by the apostles themselves, or their disciples who had the apostle's teaching still ringing in their ears.

What authority does it have?

It was revered by many to be equal to the books of the *New Testament*. Clement of Alexandria, Didymus the Blind and Origen used it as Scripture.

How was it rediscovered?

In 1873 Byrennios found it in a monastery in Constantinople (Istanbul) in Turkey.

Interesting points

- Contains instructions about the Thanksgiving (Eucharist or Communion) which can be used in a Love Feed (Agape).
- Warns us in advance that the "Deceiver of the World"
 (Antichrist) will come at the end of age and deceive people into believing he is God's Son because of the signs and miracles he performs.
- enacted the only law that would survive his reign the banning of Christianity. It was now an offence punishable by death to believe in Jesus the Christ. This was the first of the 10 great Roman persecutions that would last until AD 313. Christians of Rome were hunted down and rounded up for the games in Nero's Circus. Christians became food for killer beasts in the arena. Christians were soaked in pitch and sulphur and lit as torches along the Appian Way and for the Emperor's garden parties. Christians were forced to act as characters murdered in plays. Christian women were given as sexual prizes to the winners in gladiator contests and subsequently executed or murdered.

The Apostle Peter wrote the following to focus the Christians on the truth when facing such suffering: "...Dearly loved ones, do not be surprised at the burning among you to test and prove you, as though something strange was happening to you. To the contrary be full of

joy. The truth is that you are sharing in the sufferings of Christ which will result in you overflowing with joy and happiness when his glory is revealed" (1 Peter 4:12-13).

The persecution spread to other parts of the Empire, particularly the Christian communities in the region of Asia Minor (Turkey, Greece and Syria). Everywhere, Nero's soldiers were on the hunt for the leaders of the hated Christians who were slandered as "enemies of mankind". The Teaching of The Twelve Apostles manual would have come in great use to help the community of God's people carry on with their orderly worship of Jesus Christ in smaller communities with less or no leaders.

THE WITNESS OF THE TWELVE APOSTLES

This is the teaching of the RULER to those who are not Jews by the twelve apostles.

Food Sacrificed to Idols

Regarding food; eat what you are able, but keep strictly away from food sacrificed to idols for it involves the worship of demons.

Baptism

With respect to baptism, baptise as follows:

- Step 1: Read out the teaching of the *Two Ways of Life and Death* with the person who is to be baptised
- Step 2: The person being baptised must fast for one or two days before the day of their baptism.
- Step 3: Both the person who is doing the baptising and the person who is being baptised, must fast on the day of their baptism along with as many other people that can.
- Step 4: Baptise them in running water in the Name of:
 - (a) The Father
 - (b) The Son
 - (c) The Holy Spirit.

Notes: (i) If there is no running water then baptise in some other water. (ii) If there is no cold water available then use warm. (iii) If there is not enough water available, then pour water on their head three times in the Name of The Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit.

Fasting

Do not let your fasts coincide with those of the hypocrites. They fast on Mondays and Thursdays, but you must fast on Wednesdays and Fridays.

Praying

Do not pray like the hypocrites. Instead, pray like this, just as the RULER commanded us in His Good News:

"Our Father in heaven.

May Your Name be kept holy.

Your kingdom come.

Your will be done on earth as it is done in heaven.

Give us enough bread to eat for today.

Forgive us our sin as we have forgiven those who have sinned against us.

Do not allow us to be tempted, but deliver us from the Evil One.

Yours is the power and the glory forever and ever."

Pray that prayer three times every day.

The Thanksgiving

With regards to The Thanksgiving give thanks like this: Firstly, respects the cup;

"We thank You Father for the holy vine of Your servant David that You have made known to us through Jesus Your Son. Yours is the glory forever and ever."

Secondly, respects the broken bread;

"We thank You Father for the life and knowledge that you made known to us through Jesus Your Son. Yours is the glory forever and ever. In the same way that this bread was broken and scattered over the mountains then gathered back together into one loaf, let Your community of GOD's people be gathered together from the ends of the earth into Your kingdom. Yours is the glory and the power through Jesus the Christ forever and ever!"

No one is to eat or drink of this Thanksgiving unless they have been baptised into the Name of the RULER. With respect to this the RULER has said, "You must not give holy things to the pet dogs".

After you have had enough to eat and drink, give thanks as follows;

"We thank You Holy Father for your Holy Name which you have made to live in our hearts. We thank you too for the knowledge, faith and immortality that You have made known to us through Jesus Your Son. Yours is the glory forever and ever!

Almighty Master, You created all things for Your Name's sake and gave food and drink for people to enjoy that they might give thanks to you. To us though, You have provided spiritual food and drink with eternal life through Your Son. Above all, we thank You because You are mighty. Yours is the glory for forever and ever!

RULER, keep in mind Your community of GOD's people. Deliver her from all evil and perfect her in Your love. Make her holy and gather her together from the four winds into the kingdom that You have prepared for her.

Yours is the power and the glory forever and ever! Let grace come and let this world pass away. Hosanna to the GOD of David. If any person is holy then let him come. If anyone is unholy let them repent. The RULER will come. Amen."

Allow the prophets though, to give thanks how they want.

Whoever comes and teaches you everything written in The Two Ways of Life and Death then welcome them. If his teaching adds to the increase of righteousness and the knowledge of the RULER, then receive him in the same way as you would the RULER himself. However, if the teacher himself is off the correct path and teaches doctrine that contradicts any of this, you must not listen to him.

Apostles and Prophets

Use the Good News as your rule book in the treatment of apostles and prophets;

- Every apostle that visits should be welcomed as if he
 were the RULER but only be allowed to stay one day. If
 there is need, let him stay a second day but not for
 three days otherwise he is a false prophet.
- When it's time for the apostle to go, he must not take anything with him except bread until he reaches his next place to stay. If he asks for money he is a false prophet.
- Do not test or judge any prophet who speaks in the Spirit, for every sin will be forgiven, but this sin will not be forgiven.
- Not everyone who speaks in the Spirit is a prophet, but only he who demonstrates that they are walking in the ways of the RULER. You will therefore be able to tell the difference between a genuine prophet and a false prophet by their ways.

- Should a prophet order a meal in the Spirit, he must not eat it otherwise he is a false prophet.
- Every prophet that teaches the truth, must practice what they preach otherwise they are a false prophet.
- Every prophet who, after being tested genuine, takes action to reveal in a physical way the spiritual mystery of the community of GOD's people (provided he doesn't tell you to copy him) must not to be judged by you because GOD is the one to judge him. Anyway, the ancient prophets also behaved in a similar way.
- If anyone in the Spirit asks you for money or anything else, do not listen to him. But if he tells you to give on behalf of others that are in need, nobody must judge him.
- Everyone who visits you In the Name of the RULER is to be welcomed at first. Then use your insight to examine them and find out what is true and what is false about them.
- If the person visiting you is simply passing through, help him in any way that you can. However, he must not stay with you for more than two, or if essential, three days.
- If he wants to settle down in your community and has a trade, he must work for his living. But if he has no trade, decide among yourselves how he can live among you as a Christian without being unproductive. If he chooses not to cooperate in this way, then he is making a business out of Christ. Be very wary of this type of individual.

- Every true prophet who wants to settle down in your community deserves to eat. Likewise, every genuine teacher deserves his food as does any worker.
- You must therefore take all the first fruits produced from the vineyard, harvest and livestock then give them to the prophets as your high priests. If there is no prophet then give it to the poor.
- Should you make some bread, give the first fruits in line with the commandments. Do the same when you open some wine or oil, take the first fruits and give them to the prophets.
- With respects to money, clothing and any other property you own, take the first fruit that seems fair to you and give according to the commandment.

The RULER's Day

On every RULER's "Day of the RULER," meet together to break bread and give thanks after confessing your sins so that your sacrifice may be pure. If someone is quarrelling with a brother though, they must not join in with you until they have made up with each other for your sacrifice must not be defiled. This is the sacrifice the RULER was talking about when he said, "Everywhere and always offer me a pure sacrifice, for I am a great King says the RULER and my Name will be great among the nations".

Overseers and Assistant Overseers

You must appoint for yourselves overseers and assistant overseers worthy of the RULER. They must be men who are;

- Gentle.
- 2. Not lovers of money.
- Faithful.
- 4. Tested and proved to be true.

They likewise carry out for you the ministry of the prophets and the teachers. Therefore, you must never treat them with contempt as they are your men of respect along with the prophets and teachers.

Conclusion

Quietly correct each other, never in an angry way but in peace just as you find in the Good News. Should a person do wrong to his neighbour, nobody should speak to him or hear from you until they repent. Make sure your prayers, charitable giving and everything you do are all in-line with our RULER's Good News.

Carefully guard your life every moment. Do not allow your lamps to extinguish. Never be unprepared. Always be ready. You never know the hour when our RULER is coming.

Meet together frequently and enthusiastically search for things that do your souls good. All the time you have believed will be useless if you are not found perfect at the end.

In the last days there will be false prophets and heretics everywhere. The sheep will be turned into wolves and love will be turned into hate. As sinfulness gets worse they will hate, attack and betray each other.

Then the world's deceiver will appear claiming to be GOD's Son. He will perform signs and miracles so that the whole earth will fall into his hands. He will perform terrible abominations of a type that have never been seen before in history. All of mankind will then go through the test by fire. Great numbers will fall away and be destroyed, but those who persevere in their faith will be saved by the Cursed One himself.

After that there will appear the signs of the truth;

First: The sign of an opening in heaven.

Second: The sign of the trumpet blast.

Third: The resurrection of the dead.

But not all the dead will be resurrected for it has been said, "The RULER will come and all his special people with him". Then the world will see the "RULER coming upon the clouds of heaven".

The Good Confession

We agree with the apostles and believe that there is only one Healer who is made of both flesh and spirit, born and unborn, GOD in the flesh, true life surrounded by death, son of Mary and Son of GOD, initially experiencing suffering then afterwards beyond suffering — Jesus the Christ our RULER.

For our GOD, Jesus the Christ:

- Was conceived in Mary's womb according to the preplanning of GOD and by the Holy Spirit
- Is physically descended from the line of David according to ancestry
- Is the Son of GOD according to the will and power of GOD
- Was born the son of Mary when she was still a virgin
- Ate and drank among us, both before being killed and after being raised up to life again
- Was baptised by John in order that all righteousness might be fulfilled by him
- Was nailed and crucified for us in his physical body under Pontius Pilate and Herod the Tetrarch
- Died in full sight of persons in heaven, on earth, and under the earth

- Was physically and spiritually raised from the dead when his Father raised him up
- Was touched and handled by his disciples after his resurrection. His disciples then saw that he was composed of flesh whilst being spiritually united with the Father at the same time. For this reason, his disciples also treated death with the same contempt.

He suffered all these things for our sakes so that we might be saved and likewise be raised up from the dead by the Father if we exercise trust in Jesus the Christ.

He has raised up a standard for all ages through his resurrection, to rally together his holy and faithful people whether among Jews or non-Jews, in the one body of the Community of GOD's people.
